Eligible healthcare providers who serve as preceptors to local students may earn up to \$5,000 in tax credits. This incentive aims to increase the number of, and recognize current providers who serve as preceptors for healthcare students. The overarching goal is to grow Hawaii's primary care provider workforce.

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## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Who is an eligible "preceptor"?**

Eligible preceptors include physicians or osteopathic physicians, advanced practice registered nurses, and pharmacists who are residents of Hawaii and who maintain a professional primary care practice, in an ambulatory care setting, in this state. If you are paid specifically to teach, email [ptc@hawaii.edu](mailto:ptc@hawaii.edu) to verify eligibility.

**How do I claim the tax credit?**

Preceptors must register at [preceptortaxcredit.hawaii.edu](http://preceptortaxcredit.hawaii.edu) during the calendar year in which you precept. Local nursing, medicine, and pharmacy schools and residency programs are responsible for entering clinical rotation information on your behalf.

**How are the number of tax credits I earn calculated?**

80 hours of cumulative supervised clinical training of an eligible student/resident equates to one tax credit (\$1,000). A maximum of five tax credits may be earned per calendar year. These hours must be verified by a participating school.

**When can I expect my tax credit?**

Prior to April 15th of the following calendar year, you will be provided a formal tax form from Department of Health to claim tax credit(s).
